IMPORTANT

APPLICATION**TO CLEAN BRUSHES OR ROLLER**

Remove excess paint. Pour a small amount of Promac Brush Cleaner into a clean container. Work the cleaner thoroughly into the paint brush's bristles or roller while the paint dissolves. Squeeze out and rinse well with water.

Repeat if necessary.

TO REMOVE POLISH, OILS, GREASE AND TAR

Dab Promac Brush Cleaner onto a clean cloth and wipe polish, oil, grease or tar off.

Heavy duty degreasing: Swab Promac Brush Cleaner onto the surface using a bristle brush or broom. Leave for approximately 15 minutes, thereafter, flush surface down thoroughly with water, scrubbing with brush or broom. Repeat if necessary. In such cases, allow surface to dry before reapplying.

TO CLEAN DRIED PAINT BRUSHES, ROLLER AND PAINTING TOOLS

If enamel paint has dried on a brush or roller, soak it in Promac Paint stripper, first allowing the paint to soften and blister, thereafter cleaning with Promac Brush Cleaner. Then squeeze out and rinse with water.
